3. Listened to Teacher.

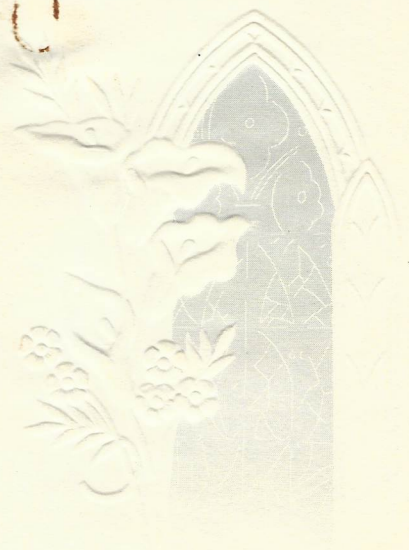
Christ is our teacher.
